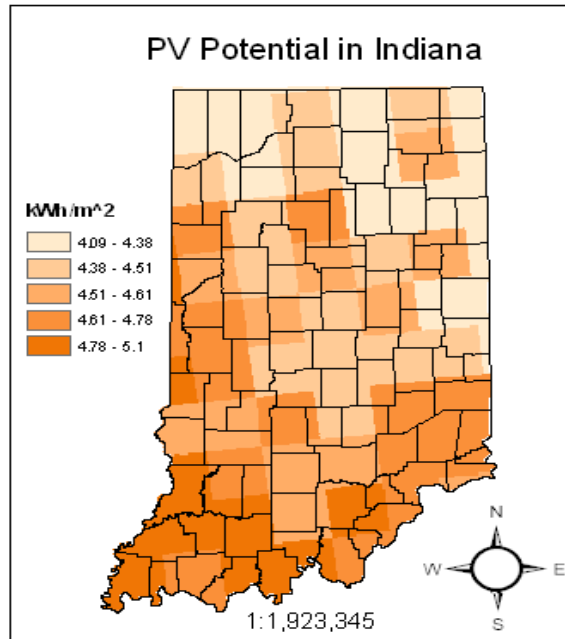

WHAT RENEWABLE ENERGY RESOURCES EXIST IN SOUTHERN INDIANA?

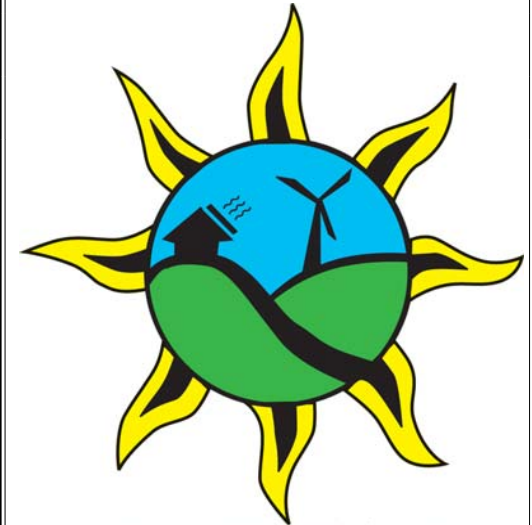


In our region there are approximately 4.5 direct sun hours on average per day. This is plenty to provide ample hot water or electricity for the energy conscious household. Solar panels may be installed on roofs, in yards with good southern exposure, or as an architectural feature such as awnings or carports. There are many efficient, innovative products available for both solar water heating and electricity production.

While Northern Indiana benefits more from wind power, there are pockets of adequate wind resources for electricity production throughout Southern Indiana.

Geothermal heat is both efficient and environmentally friendly, and it too is a viable option in Southern Indiana.

10 ENERGY CONSCIOUS TIPS

1. Turn off your computer, lights, stereo, TV and other appliances when not in use. ✓
2. Unplug adapters (eg. cell phone charger) when not in use. The charger uses energy even when it is not charging. Use a power strip for items (like an entertainment system) and turn off when not in use (anything with a remote control is always drawing electricity). ✓
3. Use compact fluorescent light bulbs or LEDs. ✓
4. Use natural lighting when possible. During the night, close your blinds/curtains to keep the heat in your room. ✓
5. Enable your computer's energy-saving features. Always turn your computer off if you will not be using it within the next hour. ✓
6. Choose energy-efficient appliances when you replace. Flat-screen monitors use 50-70% less energy. ✓
7. Adjust the temperature control on your refrigerator and hot water tank. (If coils are located behind fridge allow ample space from wall for heat dissipation. Dust coils.) ✓
8. Buy ENERGY STAR appliances. ✓
9. Use cold water when you do your laundry. ✓
10. Air dry your laundry. ✓
